Q: What's changing at Liffey Valley?

We have made changes to improve the car park experience for our customers, making it easier to find spaces and park.

New lighting, walkways, and cycle lanes have been installed throughout, and realtime parking information will help customers find a space more quickly.





There are now more parking spaces for drivers with a disability, parent and child, and new electric vehicle charging points.

We're also improving access to Liffey Valley for cyclists and pedestrians and with the introduction of a new BusConnects interchange at Liffey Valley in 2023, we're expecting to increase public transport connections to the Centre by 50%.







As of 17 October 2022, parking at Liffey Valley will cost €2.50 for the first hour, with the following two hours FREE. Our new system is ticketless and is accepting cashless payments only.

Q: How can I pay for parking at Liffey Valley?

There are three easy and convenient ways to pay for parking at Liffey Valley:

Option 1:

Making a once-off payment or registering for a Park Easy account on our website is the easiest way to pay. Registered customers will have payment taken automatically upon exiting the car park.

Option 2:

Customers can enter their vehicle registration details at a pay station, and once they approach the barrier, it will lift automatically.

Option 3:

Customers can pay directly at the exit barrier by tapping their card.

Q: Why have you made these changes?

Our goal is to provide customers with the best possible shopping experience now and for years to come. The parking experience is changing for the better, making it easier for everyone to find a space and park at Liffey Valley.

We also want to cater for more sustainable modes of transport and make it easier and more accessible for all our customers whether they drive, walk, cycle, or take the bus to Liffey Valley.



Additionally, ticketless and contactless parking is an innovative way of operating. It offers a seamless experience, speeding up queues at both the pay stations and exit barriers and helps us minimise the amount of paper we use each year.
